

Why does ASK Exist?

Because of advanced technology and educational requirements of orthodontists and their teams, braces now cost roughly \$6,000 to \$7,000.

ASK funds braces for each child in partnership with the orthodontists.

REMOVING SOCIAL BARRIERS


By removing the social barrier of severely misaligned teeth, ASK fosters hope, self-esteem, digestive health and more, while reducing the likelihood of bullying.

GRADE REQUIREMENTS

To benefit academic and future success, self-esteem and high school graduation rates, ASK requires a "C" grade in all classes before providing treatment.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

ASK helps to create community awareness and stewardship, career explorations, engaged citizens and personal growth by requiring that every child provides four hours of community service monthly.



Funding for ASK
